

ROMANS 5 – Saved from God’s Wrath Outline

Peace with God

- * Through our Lord Jesus Christ-**
 - We have been justified through faith**
 - Into His grace we stand**
- * We rejoice in the hope of the glory of God-**
 - We also rejoice in our sufferings: Suffering produces perseverance; perseverance, character; character, hope; hope does not disappoint**
 - God has poured out His love into our hearts by the Holy Spirit**
- * When we were still powerless, Christ died for the ungodly-**
 - At just the right time**
 - While we were still sinners; the Righteous died for the unrighteous**
- * Justified by Christ’s blood-**
 - Saved from God’s wrath**
 - Reconciled to God by Christ’s death**
 - Saved through His life**

Death through Adam

- * Sin entered the world through Adam-**
 - Death came through sin**
 - Death came to all men because all sinned**
 - Many died by the trespass of one man**
- * Sin was in the world before the law-**
 - Without the law, sin is not accountable**
 - But death reigned from Adam to Moses as a pattern (universal ruin)**
- * Judgment followed one sin and brought condemnation for all**
- * Through the disobedience of one man, the many were made sinners**
- * The law was added so the trespass might increase**

Life through Christ

- * The gift is not like the trespass for how much more-**
 - God’s grace through Jesus Christ did overflow to the many**
 - The gift followed many trespasses and brought justification**
 - Those who receive God’s grace and the gift of righteousness will reign in life through Jesus Christ**
- * Through the obedience of one man, Jesus, the many will be made righteous**
- * Where sin increased, grace increased all the more**
- * Just as sin reigned in death, grace reigns through righteousness to bring eternal life through Jesus our Lord**
