

## **ROMANS 10 – Israel Present Outline**

### **Israel's Unbelief Continued**

- \* Paul's heart's desire for Israel –**
  - That they be saved
  - That their zeal for God be based on righteousness not just knowledge
  - That they know Christ is the end of the law – the fulfillment
  - That they know righteousness comes to everyone who believes in Christ
- \* Righteousness by faith –**
  - Not by heroic works like bringing Christ down from heaven or up from the grave
  - But by the word of God
  - By proclaiming with your mouth that “Jesus is Lord”
  - By believing in your heart that God raised Jesus from the dead
- \* Salvation received –**
  - With your heart you believe and are justified – inward
  - With your mouth you confess and are saved – outward
  - By trust in Christ you will never be put to shame
  - There is no difference between Jew and Gentile
  - Therefore, call on the name of the Lord and be saved
- \* The Gospel process –**
  - Cannot call without believing
  - Cannot believe without hearing
  - Cannot hear without preaching
  - Cannot preach without being sent
  - How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news
- \* Not all Israel accepted the good news –**
  - They rejected the message through the word of Christ
  - They had opportunity to hear – preachers went everywhere
  - They had opportunity to understand – even the Gentiles did
  - The responsibility for Israel's rejection rested with Israel herself
  - Israel failed to meet God's requirement of faith
