ROMANS 14 – God's Judgment Seat Outline

Consider Our Differences Without Passing Judgment

- * Accept him whose faith is weak -
 - On disputable matters (non-essentials)
 - On dietary matters (with no spiritual significance)
 - We are not each other's master (God only is Master)
 - On sacred nature of special days (all days should be dedicated to God)
 - On personal conviction in matters of conduct
- Serve the Lord and give thanks for His provision
 - On special days
 - In what we eat or abstain from eating
 - In how we live and in how we die (we belong to the Lord)

For This Reason Christ Died and Returned to Life

- * Christ is Lord of both the dead and the living
- * Then why do you judge your brother?
- * We must all stand before God's judgment seat -
 - Every knee will bow, every tongue confess
 - Each will give an account of himself to God
- Let us stop passing judgment on one another
 - Remove stumbling blocks or obstacles
 - Do not cause distress to your brother by what you eat (but show love)
 - Exercise freedom with responsibility
 - Do not turn what you consider good to evil
- * The Kingdom of God -
 - Is righteousness, peace and joy in the Holy Spirit
 - Serving Christ, pleasing God
 - Mutual edification
- * Do not destroy the work of God for the sake of food -
 - All food is clean, unless by eating it causes someone else to stumble
 - So keep your preferences between yourself and God
 - Eat as a matter of faith, for everything that does not come from faith is sin
