The Day of the LORD Pictured – Verses 34:1 – 34:17

- \* Come near and listen (vs 34:1) -
  - You nations, you people (vs 34:1)
  - Let the earth and all that is in it hear (vs 34:1)
  - Let the world and all that comes out of it listen (vs 34:1)
- \* Destruction in the Day of the LORD (vs 34:2 34:4)
  - The LORD's wrath will be upon the nations' armies (vs 34:2-3):
    - He will totally destroy them (vs 34:2)
    - The dead bodies will send up a stench (vs 34:3)
    - The mountains will be soaked with their blood (vs 34:3)
  - The heavens will be shaken (vs 34:4):
    - The stars dissolved (vs 34:4):
    - The sky rolled up like a scroll (vs 34:4)
- \* The LORD has a day of vengeance and a year of retribution to uphold Zion's cause (vs 34:5 34:15)
  - God will send judgment on Edom and a sacrifice in Bozrah (vs 34:5-7)
  - Edom will be destroyed and lie desolate (vs 34:8-10)
  - God will stretch out over Edom the measuring line of chaos and the plumb line of desolation (vs 34:11)
  - Edom will have no kingdom or princes (vs 34:12)
  - Instead Edom will have thorns, nettles and brambles; jackals, owls, desert creatures, hyenas, wild goats, night creatures and falcons (vs 34:13-15)
- \* So look in the scroll of the LORD this book of prophecy (vs 34:16 34:17)
  - Nothing prophesied here will be missing for the Spirit will gather them together (vs 34:16)
  - The LORD allots their portions and distributes them, for the creatures will possess it forever (vs 34:17)

The Millennial Messianic Kingdom Pictured – Verses 35:1 – 35:10

- \* The desert will blossom (vs 35:1 2 & 35:6 7) -
  - The wilderness will rejoice (vs 35:1)
  - They will see the glory of the LORD and splendor of our God (vs 35:2)
  - Water will gush in the wilderness; sand will become a pool with bubbling springs; grass, reeds and papyrus will grow (vs 35:6b-7)
- \* Be strong, do not fear; your God will come (vs 35:3 35:6a) -
  - He comes with divine retribution to save and heal the feeble, the faint, the blind, the deaf, the lame, the mute (vs 35:3-6a)
  - Shout for joy (vs 35:6a)
- \* There will be a highway called the Way of Holiness (vs 35:8 35:10) -
  - The unclean or wicked fools will not journey on it; it will be for those who walk in that Way (vs 35:8)
  - No lions or ferocious beast will get up on it (vs 35:9a)
  - Only the redeemed will walk there, one the ransomed of the LORD will return (vs 35:9b-10)
  - The ransomed will enter Zion with singing and everlasting joy will crown their heads (vs 35:10)
  - Gladness and joy will overtake them, sorrow and sighing will flee away (vs 35:10)
