His Promises –	Redemption	Isaiah 43:1	Kinsman Redeemer(Hb: ga'al)
	Relationship	Isaiah 43:2–4	Through the water and fire
	Regathering	Isaiah 43:5–7	From four directions
	Renewal	Isaiah 43:8–9	Say “It is true”
His Purpose –	Perception	Isaiah 43:10	So that you may know, believe and understand He is “I AM”
	Propitiation	Isaiah 43:11	Without the LORD there is no savior
	Proclamation	Isaiah 43:12	You are My witnesses
	Perpetuity	Isaiah 43:13	He is sovereign and has always been
His Path –	Deliverance	Isaiah 43:14-21	From the Babylonians and the Egyptians
His Provision –	Correction	Isaiah 43:22–28	The LORD brings disgrace, destruction and scorn for their failures
His Pouring –	Blessing	Isaiah 44:1–5	Their offspring will receive the Holy Spirit

Why the LORD Will Not Forget Israel – Isaiah 44:6 – 45:25

Because:

They Are God's Witnesses –	Isaiah 44:6–8	There is none but the LORD Almighty
They Know Idol Making Warning –	Isaiah 44:9–20	Consequences of Disobedience
They will Remember Their Redeemer –	Isaiah 44:21–27	The LORD is their Kinsman Redeemer
God Will Use A Gentile King –	Isaiah 44:28- 45:13	Cyrus, His anointed (Hb: mashiach) shepherd
They will Receive Everlasting Salvation –	Isaiah 45:14–25	Israel will be saved
