- Isaiah 2:1 5 The LORD will reign from Zion on the temple mount.
- Isaiah 4:5 6 The glory of the LORD will be a canopy over Mount Zion.
- Isaiah 9:6 7 He will reign on David's throne over His kingdom with justice and righteousness from that time on and forever.
- Isaiah 11:4 10 The animal kingdom will be at peace as the earth will be full of the knowledge of the LORD.
- Isaiah 14:2 Gentile nations will participate in bringing the house of Israel back to their own land.
- Isaiah 16:5 In love a throne will be established for a man from the house of David.
- Isaiah 24:13 15,23b The remnant of Israel will acclaim the LORD's majesty as He will reign on Mount Zion gloriously.
- Isaiah 25:6 10 The LORD will prepare a feast and more.
- Isaiah 26:1 9 A song of praise will be sung in the land of Judah.
- Isaiah 29:17 24 The humble will rejoice in the LORD. Israel will no longer be ashamed. The wayward in spirit will gain understanding and those who complain will accept instruction.
- Isaiah 32:1 4 The King will reign in righteousness; His rulers will rule with justice, then eyes will be open, hearts will hear and listen, minds will know and understand and tongues will be clear.
- Isaiah 33:20 22 Jerusalem will see peace. The LORD will be our Mighty One, our Judge, our Lawgiver, our King who will save us.
- Isaiah 35:1 10 Only the redeemed will walk on the Way of Holiness as they return to Zion with singing. Everlasting joy will crown their heads.
- Isaiah 40:4 5 The glory of the LORD will be revealed, and all mankind together will see it.
- Isaiah 41:18 20 The landscape will be changed so that people may see and know, may consider and understand, that the hand of the LORD has done this, that the Holy One of Israel has created it --- because God will not forsake Israel!
- Isaiah 42:4 He establishes justice on earth.

- Isaiah 44:3 5 The LORD will pour out His Spirit on Israel's offspring and His blessing on their descendants. One will say, "I belong to the LORD", another will call himself by the name of Jacob; still another will write on his hand, "The Lord's", and will take the name of Israel.
- Isaiah 45:8, 23b 24a, 25 "Let salvation spring up, let righteousness grow with it; I, the LORD, have created it." Before Me every knee will bow, by Me every tongue will swear, they will say of Me, "In the LORD alone are righteousness and strength."
- Isaiah 49:7 12 The promised restoration of Israel: as His covenant people, the land restored, captives set free, roads and highways raised up, they will come from afar.
- Isaiah 52:13 The Servant of the LORD (Jesus) (with the Spirit of wisdom on Him) will act wisely; will be raised and lifted up and be highly exalted.
- Isaiah 55:3,12 13 The LORD will make an everlasting covenant with all who will hear and come to Him as promised to David. (the Davidic Covenant promised that a descent of David will sit on the throne of David in the Kingdom to be fulfilled by Jesus in the Messianic Kingdom). In that Kingdom, there will be joy and peace, rejoicing with song and an everlasting sign with thorn bush and briers replaced by pine tree and myrtle.
- Isaiah 59:19 21 Men will fear the name of the LORD and revere His glory for the Redeemer will come to Zion to fulfill His covenant with Israel which will last forever.
- Isaiah 60:1 22 All of it. The glory of Zion: the City of the LORD..."I will make peace your governor and righteousness your ruler...for the LORD will be your everlasting light, and your God will be your glory...your days of sorrow will end. Then will all your people be righteous and they will possess the land forever. They are the shoot I have planted...I am the LORD, in its time I will do this swiftly."
- Isaiah 65:19 25 All of it. Life in the Millennial Messianic Kingdom: "Never again will there be in it an infant who lives but a few days, or an old man who does not live out his years; he who dies at a hundred will be considered accursed. They will build houses...plant vineyards and eat their fruit...For as the days of a tree, so will be the days of My people,...the wolf and the lamb will feed together, and the lion will eat straw like the ox, but dust will be the serpent's food. They will neither harm nor destroy on all My holy mountain," says the LORD.
- Isaiah 66:18 21 All of it. The LORD says: "And I...am about to come and gather all nations and tongues and they will come and see My glory. I will set a sign among them, and I will send some of those who survive to the nations...They will proclaim My glory among the nations...They will bring them, as the Israelites bring their grain offerings to the temple of the LORD...And I will select some of them also to be priests and Levites."
