**Scripture Verses Supporting the Eternal Promise that God Made to**  
**Abraham Relative to Israel’s Restoration to the Land Yet to be Fulfilled**

<b>Genesis 13:14–17</b>	<b>Land given to Abraham’s dust of the earth offspring, <u>forever!</u></b>
<b>Genesis 15:18</b>	<b>Blood covenant that God alone walked promising Abraham the land and its defined borders</b>
<b>Genesis 17:7–8, 19</b>	<b>God’s <u>everlasting</u> covenant with Abraham’s descendants and their <u>everlasting</u> possession of the land and He will be their God</b>
<b>Genesis 26:3–4</b>	<b>The LORD confirmed the covenant with Isaac</b>
<b>Genesis 28:13–14 &amp; 35:11–12</b>	<b>The LORD confirmed the covenant with Jacob</b>
<b>Genesis 48:3–4</b>	<b>The covenant confirmed by Jacob with Joseph and his sons with the land being an <u>everlasting</u> possession to their descendants</b>
<b>Exodus 32:13</b>	<b>Moses reminded the LORD of the land covenant with them <u>forever</u></b>
<b>Leviticus 26:42–45</b>	<b>The LORD remembers the land covenant even while Israel is in exile</b>
<b>Deuteronomy 4:26–31</b>	<b>In latter days Israel will return to the LORD and <u>God will not forget</u> the covenant He made with their forefathers</b>
<b>Deuteronomy 30:2–7</b>	<b>God’s promise of Israel’s return to the land after exile</b>
<b>Psalms 105:8–11</b>	<b>Abrahamic Covenant confirmed (<u>everlasting</u> covenant)</b>
<b>Psalms 132:11–14</b>	<b>The LORD’s oath to David – enthroned in Zion <u>forever</u></b>
<b>Isaiah 11:11</b>	<b><u>God will</u> reclaim the remnant of Israel a second time</b>
<b>Isaiah 14:1</b>	<b>Once again the LORD will settle Israel in their own land</b>
<b>Isaiah 14:2</b>	<b>The house of Israel will possess the nations</b>

Isaiah 41:8–9	<b><u>God has not rejected</u> Israel (descendants of Abraham)</b>
Isaiah 43:5–7	Israel will be brought back from the east, west, north and south
Isaiah 44:21	<b><u>God will not forget</u> Israel</b>
Isaiah 45:17	Israel will be saved, not be put to shame to <u>ages everlasting</u>
Isaiah 49:8	<b><u>God will</u> restore the land of Israel</b>
Isaiah 49:15–16	<b><u>God will not forget</u> Israel; He has engraved them on the palms of His hands</b>
Isaiah 54:5–7	Israel is God’s wife and <b><u>He will</u></b> bring her back
Isaiah 60:21	Israel will possess the land <b><u>forever!</u></b>
Jeremiah 30:3, 7–11	Israel will be restored to the land; there will be a time of trouble for Jacob; Israel will have a king; Israel will live in peace and security after being disciplined
Jeremiah 31:8, 17, 23, 27–28, 35–37	Israel will be brought back to their own land and the LORD <b><u>will never reject</u></b> them as a nation
Jeremiah 32:37–41	Israel will be brought back to their land to live in safety and <b><u>God will</u></b> make an <u>everlasting</u> covenant with them
Ezekiel 11:17	The <b><u>LORD will</u></b> gather Israel from the nations and bring them back to the land of Israel again
Ezekiel 20:33–42	The <b><u>LORD will</u></b> bring Israel from the nations, execute judgment upon them in the desert and then bring them into the land of Israel given to their forefathers
Ezekiel 28:25–26	Israel will live in their own land in safety
Ezekiel 34:13	The <b><u>LORD will</u></b> bring Israel back into their own land
Ezekiel 34:27–30	Israel will be secure in their land

Ezekiel 36:	Promises concerning the land of Israel:
Vs 12	Israel <u>will never again</u> be deprived of their land (their inheritance)
Vs 24	The <u>LORD will</u> gather Israel from the nations and bring them to their own land
Vs 28	Israel will live in the land given to their forefathers and God will be their God
Vs 34	The desolate land will be cultivated
Ezekiel 37:	Dry bones:
Vs 12	The <u>LORD will</u> bring them back to the land of Israel
Vs 14	The <u>LORD will</u> settle them in their own land
Vs 21–22	The <u>LORD will</u> make them one nation in the land
Vs 25	Israel will live in the land <u>forever</u>
Ezekiel 39:27–29	The <u>LORD will</u> gather Israel to their own land and He will pour out His Spirit on the house of Israel
Ezekiel 43:7	<u>God will</u> live among the Israelites <u>forever!</u>
Joel 3:2	<u>God will</u> bring judgment against the nations who scattered His people Israel and divided up His land
Joel 3:20	Judah will be inhabited <u>forever</u> and Jerusalem through all generations
Amos 9:15	<u>God will</u> plant Israel in their own land <u>never to be uprooted</u> from the land
Obadiah 17	The House of Jacob will possess its inheritance
Zechariah 2:8	Israel is the apple of God's eye
Zechariah 10:6	<u>God will</u> restore the House of Judah and <u>not reject them</u>
