1 Kings Outline:

***King David's reign ends – 1 Kings 1:1–2 :11**

- Adonijah sets himself up as king – 1 Kings 1:1–27

• David's health began to fail with age – 1 Kings 1:1–4

• David's fourth son, Adonijah said, "I will be king." – 1 Kings 1:5–6

• Joab & Abiathar supported Adonijah; Zadok, Benaiah & Nathan did not – 1 Kings 1:7–8

• Nathan talked to Bathsheba and a counter plan was set in motion – 1 Kings 1:9–27

- David makes Solomon king – 1 Kings 1:28–2:11

• David makes clear to Bathsheba that Solomon will be king after David – 1 Kings 1:28–31

• David tells Zadok (priest) and Nathan (prophet) to anoint Solomon king – 1 Kings 32–37

• So Zadok the priest anointed Solomon as king – 1 Kings 1:38–40

• Solomon is seated, Adonijah bows, as David praises the LORD – 1 Kings 1:41–53

• As time drew near David instructs Solomon – 1 Kings 2: 1–9

• Then David dies and is buried in the City of David – 1 Kings 2:10–11

*** The reign of Solomon – 1 Kings 2:12–11:43**

- Solomon's throne established – 1 Kings 2:12–46

• Adonijah was put to death by Benaiah – 1 Kings 2:12–25

• Abiathar was removed from the priesthood of the LORD – 1 Kings 2:26–27

• Joab was killed by Benaiah and Zadok replaced Abiathar as priest – 1 Kings 1:28–35

• Benaiah killed Shimei ordered by Solomon due to wrong done to David – 1 Kings 2:36–46

- Solomon's wisdom – 1 Kings 3:1–28; 4:29–34

• Solomon showed his love for the LORD except for high place sacrifices – 1 Kings 3:1–4

• The LORD appeared to Solomon in a dream and said, "Ask for whatever you want Me to give you." – 1 Kings 3:5

• Solomon asked for a discerning heart – 1 Kings 3:6–9

• The LORD was pleased and gave Solomon what he asked for and more – 1 Kings 3:10–15

• Solomon's wise ruling: "Split the baby!" – 1 Kings 3:16–28

• Solomon's wisdom described – 1 Kings 4:29–34

- Solomon's chief officials and governors – 1 Kings 4:1–19

- Solomon's daily provisions – 1 Kings 4:20–28

- Preparations for building the temple – 1 Kings 5:1–16

- Solomon builds the temple – 1 Kings 6:1–38

- Solomon builds his palace – 1 Kings 7:1–12

- Temple's furnishings – 1 Kings 7:13–51

- Ark brought to the temple; Solomon's blessing and prayer of dedication – 1 Kings 8:1–66

- The LORD appears to Solomon – 1 Kings 9:1–9

- Solomon's wives – 1 Kings 11:1–13
 - He had 700 wives and 300 concubines – 1 Kings 11:3
 - His wives turned his heart after other gods – 1 Kings 11:4
 - Solomon did evil in the eyes of the LORD – 1 Kings 11:6
 - The LORD said, "I will tear the kingdom away from you and give it to one of your subordinates." – 1 Kings 11:11
- Solomon's adversaries – 1 Kings 11:14–25
- Jeroboam rebels against Solomon – 1 Kings 11:26–40
- Solomon's death – 1 Kings 11:41–43
- * The kingdom is divided – 1 Kings 12:1–14:31
 - Israel rebels against Rehoboam – 1 Kings 12:1–24
 - Golden calves at Bethel and Dan – 1 Kings 12:25–33
 - The man of God from Judah confronted King Jeroboam – 1 Kings 13:1–34
 - Ahijah's prophecy against Jeroboam – 1 Kings 14:1–20
 - Rehoboam king of Judah – 1 Kings 14:21–31
- * Kings of Judah and Israel – 1 Kings 15:1–16:28
 - Abijah of Judah – 1 Kings 15:1–8
 - Asa king of Judah – 1 Kings 15:9–24
 - Nadab king of Israel – 1 Kings 15:25–32
 - Baasha King of Israel – 1 Kings 15:33–16:7
 - Elah king of Israel – 1 Kings 16:8–14
 - Zimri King of Israel – 1 Kings 16:15–20
 - Omri King of Israel – 1 Kings 16:21–28

 - Ahab becomes king of Israel – 1 Kings 16:29–34
 - Elijah fed by ravens – 1 Kings 17:1–6
 - The widow at Zarephath – 1 Kings 17:7–24
 - Elijah and Obadiah – 1 Kings 18:1–15
 - Elijah on Mount Carmel – 1 Kings 18:16–46

 - Micahiah prophesies against Ahab – 1 Kings 22:1–28
 - Ahab killed at Ramoth Gilead – 1 Kings 22:29–40
- * Jehoshaphat and Ahaziah – 1 Kings 22:41–53
 - Jehoshaphat king of Judah – 1 Kings 22:41–50
 - Ahaziah king of Israel – 1 Kings 22:51–53
